Notes

This form should be completed by an individual who is of the age of 18 or over and is a:

1. Resident

A resident is a person who:

- lives in the Council area; **and**
- has lived in the property for at least one month; **and**
- is not on the State Electoral Roll (i.e. House of Assembly Roll).

or

2. Sole Owner

A sole owner is a person who:

- owns property in the Council area; **and**
- only owner of the relevant property.

or

3. Sole Occupier

A sole occupier is a person who:

- occupies property in the Council area as a tenant; **and**
- does not live in that property (a non resident occupier).

Enrolment can only be granted in respect to the rateable property address nominated on the front of this form. Where applicants are seeking enrolment for additional properties (located in different wards in the Council area) a separate application form must be completed in respect to each property.

An elector can only vote once for an Area election (i.e. for a Mayor or Area Councillors) and once in any Ward election (i.e. for Ward Councillors).

Please complete all sections in this Application for Enrolment form and return to the Chief Executive Officer of the Council you are applying to for enrolment.

Maximum penalty: \$10,000
